**Way Out West** covers the range from Nogales, Arizona to Telluride, Colorado and from El Paso, Texas to Quartzite, Arizona. They've even taken their brand of Western music, poetry, and entertainment to München, Ulm, and Dasing, Germany and to Zurich, Switzerland. That's a mighty far piece and pretty wet

hoofing some of the way! But **Way Out West** gets to people where they live and wherever they are!



**Emmy Creigh**, with her smile, mastery of the guitar and mandolin, and fine voice, brings a wealth of talent to **Way Out West**. Born in Kansas, Emmy arrived in Arizona early on, learning to ride and to love the landscapes of the Southwest and Tucson. She summered in

Colorado and grew up listening to Marty Robbins. She penned one of **Way Out West**'s favorite tunes "Arizona April," while considering how she missed the beautiful spring of a Sonoran desert. In addition to guitar and mandolin, Emmy adds the *cascabeles* (shakers), and her lovely voice blends remarkably with Tom and Slim when she croons songs of the West.

**Tom Poley** is also known as the "Bavarian Buckaroo" is a 5-string philosopher in a 10-gallon hat. Tom is a multi-instrumentalist (banjo, guitar, mandolin, and harmonica) and writes, sings, and plays Western music from the heart and with a deep love of the Southwest! In Tom's own words, "We are **Way Out West** ... with the emphasis on Way Out!" He's responsible for memorable tunes like "The Old Bar None" and "Wild Wild, West!" When Tom straps on his banjo, he adds the ringing thrill of bluegrass music to the traditional sounds of



Western. And he cooks a mean *chiles rellenos*, to boot!

**F**inally, there is **Slim**. It's a name that he is living down to, mostly by hauling around the bunkhouse ("doghouse") bass that he uses to set the pace for **Way Out West**. Like Emmy and Tom, Slim brings song writing talent to the trio. "Arizona Moon" is a love song with a gentle, loping rhythm that appeals to the lovers of traditional Western music.



**Way Out West** delivers a truly "live" show of traditional music and stories of cowboys, ranchers, and settlers of the American West. When the crowd is ready to move,
